Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: I entered the previous student ideas competition, Venture Out, and was not successful, am I able to enter Bright Ideas?

A: Yes.

Q2: I have won the Venture Out student ideas competition previously, am I able to enter Bright Ideas?

A: Yes, as long as your idea is new.

Q3: I'm a PhD student, am I eligible to enter?

A: Absolutely – anyone with student status at The University of Manchester is welcome to enter this student ideas competition.

Q4: I have multiple ideas, am I able to enter multiple times?

A: Unfortunately no; you may only enter this competition **once**, whether that is individually or as a team.

Q5: When will the results be announced?

A: The winners will be announced on Thursday, 3 December 2020.

Q6: If I am successful, how will I receive my cash prize?

A: All cash prizes will be paid directly to the Lead Entrant listed on the competition entry, unless otherwise agreed with the Director of the Masood Entrepreneurship Centre.

Q7: Are there any restrictions as to what the prize money can be spent on?

A: Although it is encouraged that the prize money is to be spent on further developing your idea or entrepreneurial skills, there are no limitations as to how you choose to spend your cash prize.
