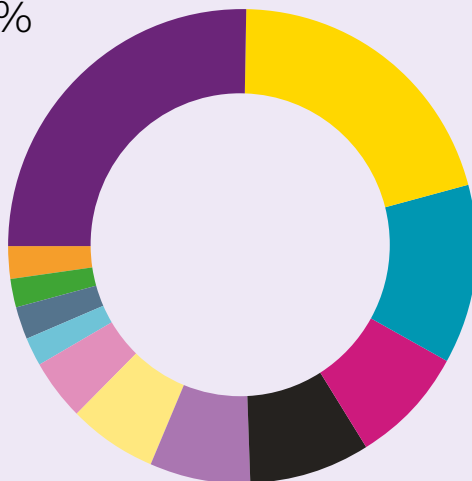
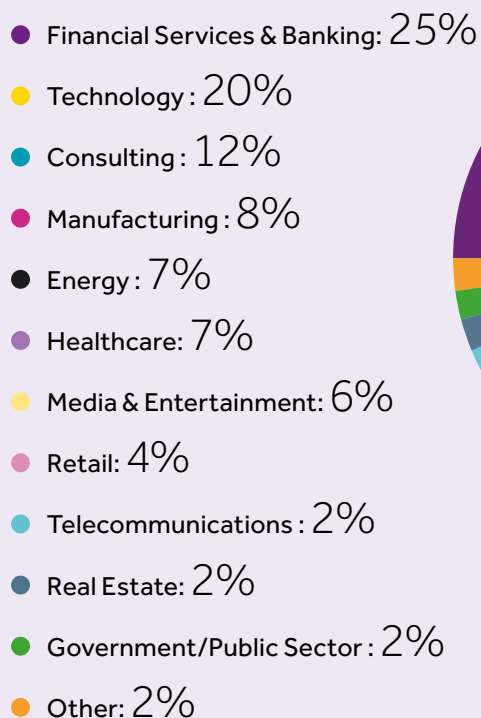

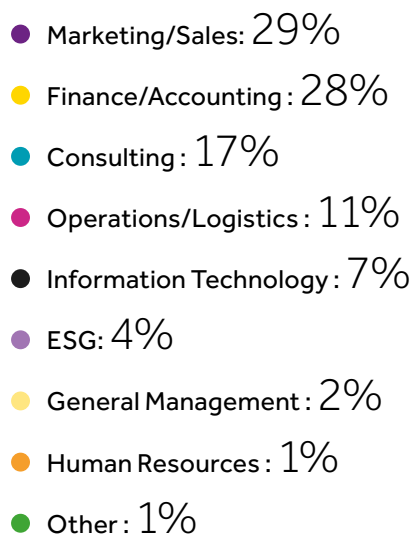

"I self-sourced an internship with the Premier League's Leadership and Workforce Development team, where I led an impact assessment research project over the summer. The project involved both quantitative and qualitative analysis to evaluate the effectiveness of their leadership programmes on Academy football development across the Premier League and EFL.

Following the advice from Postgraduate Careers Service, I proactively reached out to the team after making an initial connection and offered my support. This opportunity evolved into a year-long consultancy contract with the Premier League where I then helped operational delivery of their leadership programmes.

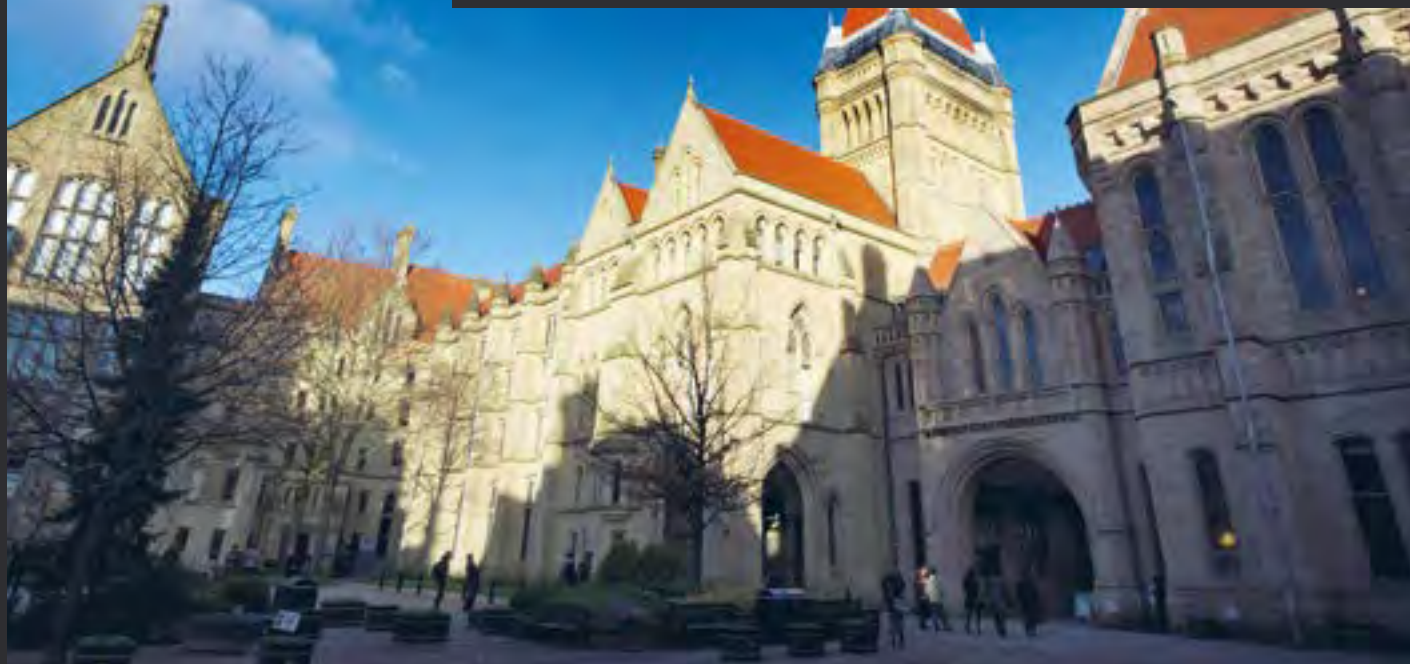
I also learned a great deal from my manager, gaining the technical skills needed for the role while preparing for life after the MBA.”
